
Interpretation of Collision safety performance evaluation results

The number of stars (out of a possible five stars) is determined based on points for pedestrian protection performance evaluation, passenger protection performance evaluation, and PSBR evaluation. Higher numbers of stars indicate fewer injuries to drivers, passengers, and pedestrians.



Indicates the cars that received the best rating $(\star\star\star\star\star)$ in the collision safety performance evaluation.



Indicates that SCA was evaluated in a side collision test.



Indicates that the evaluation criteria have been met.

Test results are rated according to five levels. Higher levels indicate better passenger protection performance.

Test results are rated according to five levels. Higher levels indicate better pedestrian head protection performance.

The test results are rated according to five levels. Higher levels indicate better pedestrian leg protection performance.

Test results are rated according to five levels. Higher levels indicate better PSBR performance.
